Format: Halfpipe - Best of 2 runs - Qualification round with medals for age categories. Scheduled with two qualification heats for men (top 4 from each heat advance to finals with the next 4 highest scores advancing as wild cards); Followed by 2 Run Final for 8 Females and 12 Males for Overall Halfpipe medal winners.

ENTRY FEES

The base fee cost for a provincial event is \$100 Plus \$30 event fee. Total \$130.

There is no bib deposit charge. Bibs must be returned at the end of qualifications and/or final at the base of the pipe.

LIFT TICKETS

Athletes \$25 lift tickets available at COP Guest Services with your bib. Coach's complementary pass can be obtained from the competition Registration desk in the cafeteria area.
